

Bible Course

Dear Friends

Some general updates and housekeeping issues for you this week.

God in Love Unites Us Report - As previously reported, the Church Council will need to consider its response to the above report, and most significantly, whether to permit our buildings to be used for same sex marriages. At a previous Church Council Meeting, it was agreed that there would be a single item extra ordinary Church Council to consider this matter further. Whilst the decision on this matter is for Church Council members only, the encouragement is for anyone who wishes to attend from within the life of the church to do so. The meeting will be held at 2.15pm on Tuesday 7th June at Church.

Church Council - There is a "normal" Church Council at 2.15 on Tuesday 14th June at Church. This is open to all with Church Council members having voting rights.

General Church Meeting - Normally we hold our GCM in the Spring, although given Covid our last meeting was only in November 2021. We will hold the meeting for 2022 on Sunday 4th September after the morning service. In 2023 we will revery back to a date in Spring. This meeting is open to everyone within the life of the Church, with Church members having voting rights.

Sabbatical - Our Superintendent Minister, Rev Marie-Anne Kent, is now on sabbatical through until the end of August.
