Dear Friends

I know the Southport and Area Schools Worker Trust (SASWT) is close to the hearts of many of you. With few children in our churches, their work of bringing the gospel to young people in innovative and creative ways is a gift. We are blessed to have the Trust in our town, and I know that you hold their workers, Tabz and Hettie, in your prayers.

On Saturday 15th July at Christ Church in Southport there are three events taking place under "A Vision of Hope" banner. You are invited go along and support the SASWT at this event. The idea is for Christians across Southport with a heart for mission to celebrate the amazing ways HOPE has been spreading throughout thousands of young people in our schools this past year. Then to swap ideas for mission in the year ahead.

So on the Saturday 15th July at Christ Church the following will be taking place...

- **11.00am 12.30pm SASW Trust End of Year Schools Celebration** featuring the voices of Southport's children and young people.
 - **1.30pm 3.30pm Keynote Speakers** with inspiring talks and round table discussions...come and encourage and share ideas.
- **3.30pm 5.00pm A Time of Worship & Prayer for Southport**, led by favourite artists from the SonFest family.

The SASWT has recently written to Churches across the town seeking investment to help bring HOPE to an emerging generation. Currently their annual budget is £60,000, although year on year they have a £20,000 shortfall. Thank you to everyone who so generously donated to the recent charity bike ride, which with Gift Aid will have raised about £9,500. The SASWT has a heart to extend their ministry with young people still further. To realise their vision they have calculated an annual budget of £135,000 will be required.

This week as a Circuit, the Circuit Meeting has pledged £7,500 per annum for three years. The hope is that local Methodist Churches will be able to raise a further £2,500 per annum so that the Methodist support will be £10,000 for the next three years.
