How well are we known? Although we are cautious about how much we share with others about ourselves and our lives, we are known intimately by god.

The first six verses of the message version of psalm 139 reads;

God, investigate my life;
get all the facts firsthand.
I'm an open book to you;
even from a distance, you know what I'm thinking.
You know when I leave and when I get back;
I'm never out of your sight.
You know everything I'm going to say
before I start the first sentence.
I look behind me and you're there,
then up ahead and you're there too,
your reassuring presence, coming and going.
This is too much, too wonderful, I can't take it all in!

The extent to which we are known and valued by god is beyond our comprehension. How do we value others and how are we valued by others as we travel through our Christian journey?

In the tv programme 'surgeons on the edge' I watch in awe at the extent of surgery that can be done particularly when reconstruction is involved. A large team work together for lengthy hours valuing each others contribution as they work towards the same goal, enhancing the life of the patient.

As individuals, and as a church, may we, as followers of Jesus Christ value all we meet. A crumpled, well used five pound note has as much value as a pristine new one, people likewise have the same value regardless of their background and circumstances.
