### How do you pray?

This is a questions I've been asked twice in the last few days, once from some long standing Methodists and the other time from the Year 5 class of Kings Meadow Primary School in Woodvale. On both occasions there were preconceived ideas about what prayer should be.

I find we often have angst about our prayer life because we feel we don't pray often enough, or our minds drift off onto other issues, or we don't use proper prayer language - like what we should! If any of this resonates with you, or you just want to find out some more about prayer, then I'm delighted the Circuit is offering the space for you to explore. I perceive prayer is a personal act between us and God, and we get hung up on the "rightness" of prayer to the detriment of strengthening our relationship with God.



No need to book, just turn up on the day. Everyone welcome! On Saturday 22nd February, drop into the Circuit Presence Event - A Day of Connection, being held at Leyland Road Methodist Church.

Recent experience will be important as you deliver training, update and maintain confidential records, and enable our churches to deliver a high standard of safeguarding. You will work flexibly both in the delivery of your working hours and the location of your work and will need your own transport.

You will be required to have a satisfactory Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service Check and must promote the safeguarding and welfare of children, young people and vulnerable people within the circuit.
