Eternal Wall of Answered Prayer

Following on from the article about the Prayer Hand, here's an encouraging piece of news relating to prayer in the UK.

The Eternal Wall of Answered Prayer is going to be a piece of public art about Jesus and Christianity. It has now reached the stage where building will soon begin. It will be open for everybody to visit and enjoy, igniting the conversation about the importance of Christian prayer in the modern world.



The Eternal Wall will be built in Coleshill near Birmingham, UK and 500,000 journeys will pass the landmark every week. With visibility from up to six miles away, Eternal Wall will be seen from the M42 and M6. Flights to and from nearby Birmingham Airport shall also have excellent views of Eternal Wall from every angle.

Eternal Wall is designed in the shape of an infinity loop called a Möbius strip, a surface which has neither beginning nor end and which can never be classed as a static, finite wall. It will have one million bricks, each with an answered prayer which can be accessed digitally as well as on the structure. The continuous nature of the band represents how God is always listening and always answering our prayers. The monumental structure will rise 51.5m into the sky!
